



Photos module link in navigation menu



Buttons for creating albums and managing album permissions


• Upload photos into albums or the Photos area, which displays all your project photos.

• Group photos by their linked items in the Photos area.






Photos grouped by record type in the Photos area

When you upload and link a photo or select and link a photo from the File Library to an item, the photo also becomes available in the Photos module. If you edit the photo in the photo viewer, those changes are synced to the photo in the File Library. However, the syncing is one-way from the Photos module to the File Library.

**Note:** If you previously uploaded image files (for example, by uploading them into the File Library or by uploading and linking them to a record), those image files will be converted to photos. Then they will be available in the Photos module.

## Budget - Units, hours, and quantities


When the new units and hours setting is on, you can track units, hours, and quantities in your project budget. The related columns are available in the budget, as well as in contract invoices, PCOs, and purchase orders.




1. In the portfolio or project settings for budgets, turn on the units and hours setting.



Setting for units and hours for budgets


2. *Optional:* In the portfolio or project settings, edit the Units of Measure (UOM) lookup list, which is used for budget items.

3. In the budget, add budget items with the units, hours, and quantity information.






Units, hours, and quantity fields for budget items






• The buttons for adding budget items and transferring amounts have been moved to the right side.
